DEDICATION to owners in FPS

WHEREAS, NORTH BEACH DEVELOPMENT COMPANY, a Florida corporation, has heretofore developed and platted certain lands owned by it in St. Lucie County, Florida, as a subdivision known as "Fort Fierce Shorea" and,

WHEREAS, North Beach Development Company has sold numerous lots in said subdivision to the general public, and,
